

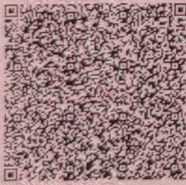

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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

BETWEEN

RABINDRANATH TAGORE UNIVERSITY (RTU), HOJAI, ASSAM

AND

DISTRICT CIVIL HOSPITAL, HOJAI, ASSAM

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Rabindranath Tagore University (RTU), Hojai, a State Public University established under the Rabindranath Tagore University Act, 2017, Government of Assam, committed to promoting academic excellence, research, social responsibility, and community engagement. RTU emphasizes multidisciplinary, experiential, and inclusive learning aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, fostering partnerships with social actors to bridge academic knowledge with real world challenges. – **THE FIRST PARTY**

District Civil Hospital, Hojai, at **Jorapukhuri** was built as an upgraded government health facility to serve Hojai town and surrounding areas and to provide district-level secondary care closer to local residents. The new hospital building was formally inaugurated by Dr. Himanta Biswa Sarma, Hon'ble CM, Assam State in February 2021. Since inauguration the facility has been presented as a fully equipped civil/district hospital (multi-storey complex with emergency and specialty units) and has been used for staff training and rolling out services to the local population. – **THE SECOND PARTY**

That the **FIRST PARTY** being empowered by Rabindranath Tagore University Act 2017, section 6 and interested to open professional courses of nursing science maintaining the Minimum Standard Requirement (MSR) as per the Assam Gazette Notification dated 7th November, 2023, for permitting clinical exposure and training of students, agreed to execute MoU with the **SECOND PARTY**.

1. PREAMBLE

Whereas the **Rabindranath Tagore University, Hojai** is authorized to introduce, conduct, and award undergraduate and postgraduate programmes in health sciences, including the **Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) in Nursing**, in accordance with the University Statutes, and Indian Nursing Council (INC) regulations, and other applicable statutory bodies;

Whereas the **District Civil Hospital, Hojai** is a recognized Hospital with adequate bed strength, clinical departments, patient load, and infrastructure required for clinical training


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of nursing students as per the norms of the **Indian Nursing Council (INC), State Nursing Council**, and other regulatory authorities;

Whereas the Parties recognize the need for qualified nursing professionals and desire to collaborate for academic and clinical training to facilitate the opening and smooth functioning of a **B.Sc. Nursing programme**;

Now, therefore, the Parties hereby agree to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on the following terms and conditions:

2. OBJECTIVES OF THE MoU

The objectives of this MoU are:

1. To establish academic-clinical collaboration for starting and conducting a **B.Sc. Nursing course** under the University.
2. To provide structured clinical training, internship, and hands-on exposure to nursing students at the Hospital.
3. To ensure compliance with norms and standards prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council, State Nursing Council, and other statutory authorities.
4. To promote quality nursing education, research, and community health services.

3. SCOPE OF COLLABORATION

This MoU covers the following areas:

- Clinical training and internship of B.Sc. Nursing students.
- Utilization of hospital facilities for teaching and learning purposes.
- Academic supervision and evaluation of students.
- Joint participation in healthcare services, outreach programmes, and continuing nursing education.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE UNIVERSITY

The University shall:

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1. Obtain necessary approvals and affiliations from statutory and regulatory bodies (DME/INC/State Nursing Council/Government, as applicable).
2. Design and implement the B.Sc. Nursing curriculum as per INC and University norms.
3. Appoint qualified teaching faculty as per prescribed standards.
4. Conduct admissions, examinations, evaluation, and award of degrees.
5. Provide professional indemnity and insurance coverage for students, where required.
6. Ensure discipline, academic integrity, and adherence to hospital rules by students.

5. RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE HOSPITAL

The Hospital shall:

1. Provide clinical training facilities to B.Sc. Nursing students as per INC norms.
2. Allow access to wards, OPDs, ICUs, operation theatres, laboratories, and community health centres for clinical learning.
3. Designate qualified medical and nursing personnel as clinical instructors/supervisors.
4. Maintain necessary patient load, bed strength, and clinical infrastructure.
5. Facilitate inspections by statutory bodies related to the B.Sc. Nursing programme.
6. Ensure a safe and conducive learning environment for students.

6. STUDENT TRAINING AND DISCIPLINE

1. Students shall follow the rules, regulations, and code of conduct of both the University and the Hospital.
2. The Hospital shall have the right to report any misconduct or indiscipline to the University for appropriate action.
3. Students shall not be entitled to any stipend or employment benefits unless specifically notified by the Government or agreed separately.

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7. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENTS

1. This MoU does not create any financial liability on either Party unless mutually agreed in writing.
2. Any fees, honorarium, or cost-sharing arrangements, if applicable, shall be governed by separate written agreements or Government orders.

8. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY AND CONFIDENTIALITY

1. Any academic material, research output, or data generated during the collaboration shall be governed by applicable University and Government policies.
2. Patient confidentiality and ethical standards shall be strictly maintained at all times.

9. DURATION AND TERMINATION

1. This MoU shall be valid for a period of **five (5) years** from the date of signing.
2. The MoU may be renewed by mutual written consent of both Parties.
3. Either Party may terminate this MoU by giving **six (6) months' prior written notice**, subject to ensuring that the interests of enrolled students are protected.

10. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

Any dispute arising out of or in connection with this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual consultation. In case of failure, the matter shall be referred to the **Principal Secretary/Commissioner, Health & Family Welfare Department, Government of Assam**, whose decision shall be final and binding.

11. AMENDMENTS

Any amendment or modification to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both Parties.

12. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION



This MoU shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India, and the courts at the Hojai District headquarter of Assam shall have exclusive jurisdiction.

13. MISCELLANEOUS


1. This MoU is non-exclusive in nature.
